Tallahassee Community College requires all first-time students and transfer students, who have not successfully completed a college level math and English course <u>and who are not exempt</u> <u>from placement testing as defined by statute</u>, to take a college level placement test. In accordance with Florida Administrative Code 6A-10.0315, students may use the ACT, the SAT, <u>PERT</u>, <u>ACCUPLACER</u>, or FCAT 2.0 Reading. Scores must be less than two years old to be valid. or the State approved college-entry placement test as long as the scores are not older than two years. The College accepts the standard scores as defined in the <u>Florida Aa</u>dministrative <u>Ce</u>ode.

The College may use other measures of student achievement in addition to common placemente test scores in order to advise students of enrollment options related to their chosen meta-major.
