Quincy House

- Services and Programs
 - Testing center
 - Adult education and GED services
 - ACT and FCAT tutorial services
 - After-school programs
- 21st Century Programs (off-site)
 - Two grants operated at the Quincy House serving 400 students at three schools
 - ▶ \$720,000 in funding for programs



Quincy House



Quincy House

- Serves nearly 500 middle and high school students in Gadsden County
- Most participants come from low-income, disadvantaged households
- Services
 - Academic, financial, career and personal counseling
 - Career exploration and aptitude assessment
 - Tutorial services and test preparation
 - Exposure to college campuses

Services

- Information on student financial assistance and financial literacy
- Assistance in completing college admissions and financial aid applications
- Assistance in preparing for college entrance exams
- Special activities for sixth, seventh and eighth graders
- Workshops for the families of participants

- College Readiness Computer Camp
 - ETS partnered with BUC Technologies to introduce students to careers in renewable energy and biotechnology
 - Students developed educational portfolios, explored careers, discovered their learning styles and investigated colleges and majors
 - Program made subject matter interesting and accessible, introduced students to STEM fields

2013-14 Successes

- 97% of our 6th through 11th grade students were promoted to the next grade level
- 70% of our high school seniors graduated from high school
- 77% of our high school seniors enrolled in a program of postsecondary education (an additional 10% enlisted in the military or found gainful employment)
- Approximately 80% of our college enrollees chose TCC as their college of choice

Take Stock in Children & College Reach Out Program

- TSIC and CROP serve 250 students throughout the tri-county service area (94 from Gadsden County)
- Services


- 97% of our 6th through 11th grade students were promoted to the next grade level

Gadsden Re-Entry Center

- Opened in December 2013
- Public-private partnership with the Department of Corrections, Unlimited Path and TCC
- Provides comprehensive services to inmates to ease their transition back into society
- Goal to reduce recidivism

Gadsden Re-Entry Center

- TCC is the only college in America with a prison on its campus
- Center highlights and population profile
 - Facility houses 432 inmates
 - 36 months or less remaining on their sentences
 - Returning to communities in North Florida

TCC's Role at the Re-Entry Center

- Literacy services
- GED training
- Vocational training
 - Culinary arts
 - Industrial machine repair and maintenance
 - Carpentry
 - Masonry

Inmate Productivity

- Total enrolled in GED and literacy classes:100
- Total enrolled in vocational programs:131
- 48 have completed the GED program, 19 earned their diplomas
- 85% passed at least one subject of the test
- 284 industry recognized certificates have been earned


