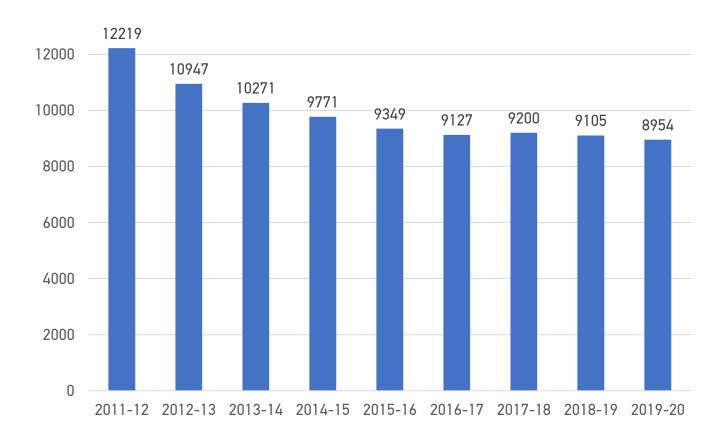

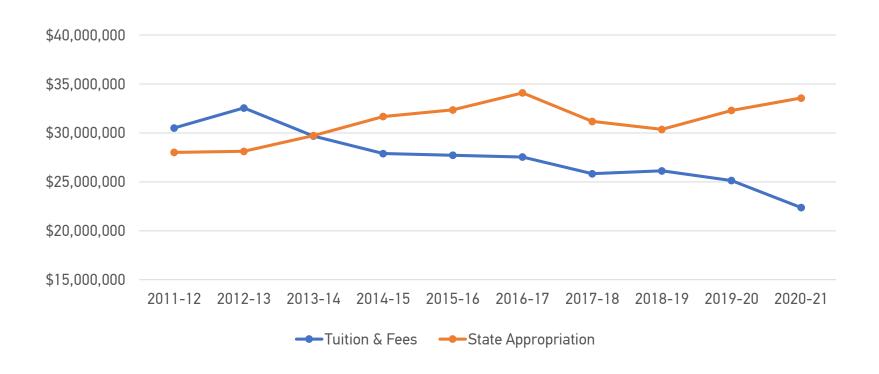

## Student FTE



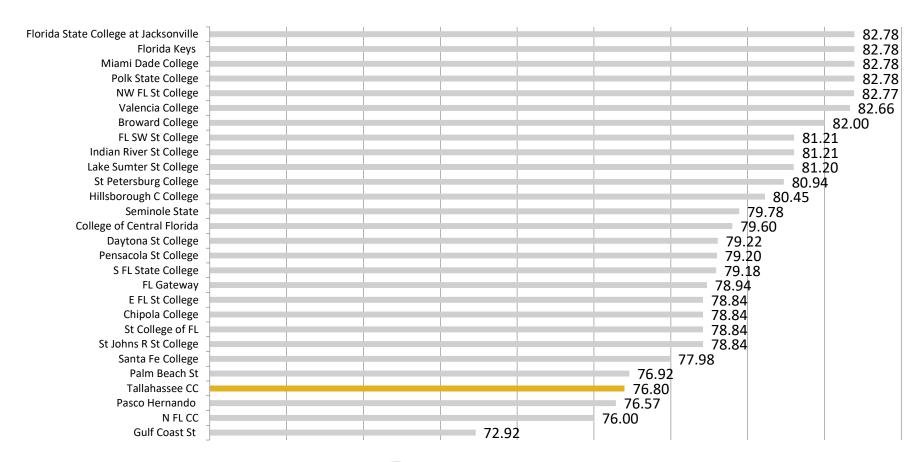


## College Revenue

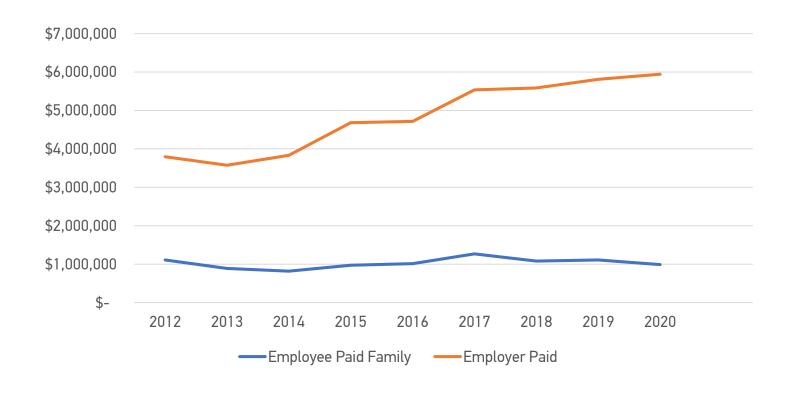

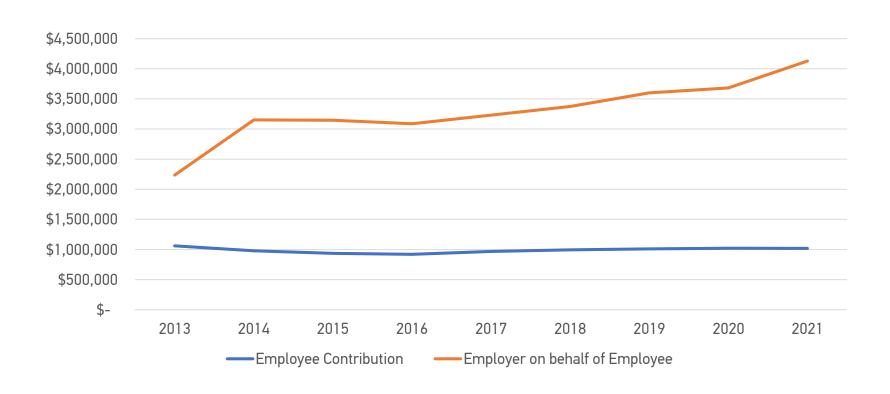


#### Insurance Costs
