Takeaways:

- While TCC's credit enrollment decreased for fall 2022, the Strategic Enrollment Management committee is analyzing trends and identifying emerging markets and opportunities.
- TCC welcomed a historic 316 students into the Honors Program this fall.
- Early successes in the Pathways to Persistence program are showing a 4% decrease in the equity gap.
- Non-credit enrollment increased by 165% over the past year, reflecting national, state, and local trends towards workforce education.
