**NON-EMERGENCY** REPORTING: Call TSC Police **850-201-6100**

## ACTIVE THREAT

**CALL 911**

**Avoid**  
**Deny**  
**Defend**



**Avoid / RUN**  
When there is an active threat



**CALL 911**  
After you're safe

**Deny**  
- Barricade doors  
- Turn off lights  
- Get out of sight  
- Silence your cell



**Defend**  
- As a last resort  
- Life is in danger  
- Defend Yourself.

## FIRE EMERGENCY + BUILDING EVACUATION

**CALL 911**



**CALL 911**



**S. = SAVE** those in danger  
**A. = ACTIVATE** the fire alarm  
**V. = VOCALIZE** "Fire! Fire! Fire!"  
**E. = EVACUATE** the building\*

\*Assemble at least 300ft. from building.

## UTILITY FAILURE (E.G. LOSS OF POWER)



During power outage neither the Campus Police nor Maintenance will know the extent or length of the power outage until utility crews respond.

- If an emergency exists immediately call **Campus Police** 850-201-6100

## IMMINENT SEVERE WEATHER (E.G. TORNADO)



### WARNING

- SEVERE WEATHER has been sighted
- Seek appropriate shelter
- Look for \*ENS updates
- Monitor weather broadcasts
- AVOID: windows, elevators, and large rooms

OR

### WATCH

- Severe weather development conditions exist
- Monitor weather broadcasts for updates

\*ENS = Emergency Notification System
