Course Outline:

This 16-hour ASHI course will provide a simple, practical program to help develop or refine basic life support knowledge, skills, and the confidence to respond to a life-threatening emergency and when it is possible, to save or restore life. Instructor students will learn the legal aspects of CPR, evaluate and ensure instructor students have good teaching knowledge of CPR skills, and how to effectively teach the skills to students attending the CPR class.

Students will leave with a CPR Instructor Card that fulfills the CPR requirement to apply for their CJSTC First Aid Instructor certification.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting salary incentive.
