Course Outline:

At the completion of this 40-hour CJSTC course, participants will be able to write and review standard narrative reports.

Participants will write in a direct style that can easily be interpreted by a supervisor or state attorney. Emphasis will be placed upon specificity, accuracy, the use of grammar, the importance of spelling, and the use of punctuation.

Course Objectives:

- Gathering facts for reports
- Demonstrate how to write a report using direct style
- Edit reports for clarity, completeness, and objectivity

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
