Course Outline:

Basic Ballistic Shield Concepts is a comprehensive two-day training program designed to familiarize beginner to intermediate shield users with the shield's functions and applications. The course delves into the historical origins of the shield, tracing its evolution from military contexts to its current use in law enforcement.

Required Equipment:

- 400 rounds of pistol and 100 rifle ammo
- NLTA pistol and rifle (or conversion kit) and 100 rounds for each
- Vest, Duty Gear, and Shield (if you have one)
- Protective gear (head, hands, etc)

All ammo, except NLTA rounds, will be provided to Region XV officers if needed.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
