Course Outline:

This 40-hour course CJSTC course is designed to enhance and build on basic skills, knowledge, and ability for investigating child abuse crimes. This course will take the investigator from the initial call through prosecution and provide best practices for investigating this type of crime.

Course Objectives:

- Responding to the scene and recognizing child physical abuse, neglect, and child emotional abuse
- Medical exams and forensic interviews
- Evidence collection and reporting writing
- Prepairing for a successful prosecution

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
