

Canine Electronic Storage Detection Course Region XV

Course Outline:

This 16-hour course will educate electronic storage detection (ESD) canine handlers on the science behind electronic storage detecting, training and deployment considerations, and water hides. Canine's will take part in several scenarios during this course.

The Canine Team needs to be certified or trained on the ESD odors to attend.

FPSI will facilitate the scenarios. Please bring any personal items, clothing, leads, harnesses, etc. you would need for indoor and outdoor scenarios/hides.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
