Course Outline:

This course will provide refresher training for instructors who have allowed their CJSTC General Instructor certification to expire. This course provides a refresher of the instructor's knowledge, skills, and abilities to provide effective training to criminal justice practitioners in those subject areas dictated by local needs.

Course Objectives:

- Explain law as it pertains to liability when acting as an instructor
- Describe the purpose of a lesson plan and practice creating one.
- Review the requirements of obtaining and maintaining all levels of CJSTC instructor certifications.
