Course Outline:

This 80-hour CJSTC course will provide new line supervisors with the basic supervisory skills needed to function in a criminal justice agency. Tailored to the new supervisor, this course will assist the student with understanding the transition from operations to management responsibilities. It will also provide the experienced supervisor with the additional knowledge, skills, and attributes to function effectively in this significant role.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
