Course Outline:

This 40-hour course is for Law Enforcement or Correctional Officers in a supervisory or management position and is designed to enhance and build on basic skills, knowledge, and ability for developing leadership skills necessary for successful performance in the criminal justice field.

Course Objectives:

- Understand the middle manager's role and responsibilities to ensure the success of the organization
- Identify the general principles of leadership, including the personal style of leadership and how this style influences and motivates subordinates
- Provide techniques for effective decision problem-solving, and delegation
- Understand agency liability, potential risks, and the responsibilities of middle managers

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
