Course Outline:

The Patrol Rifle Instructor class will bring your shooting and teaching to the next level by building your confidence, speed, and efficiency. Be prepared to have an exceptional understanding of your own rifle skills through time standards and reps. This (3) day class will go well beyond the basics of a standard patrol rifle class as we take the time to build each student up around the fundamentals of shooting and prepare them for real world encounters.

Required Equipment:

- 1500 rounds of carbine and 200 pistol
- AR or AK style carbine w/sling
- Pistol w/holster
- 3 each rifle and pistol mags
- Vest, Duty Gear, eye and ear protection.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
