

Pistol Mounted Optics Instructor REGION III

Course Outline:

In this two day "Instructor - Level" class each student will walk through how to navigate running a pistol mounted optic on your handgun. Students will understand the advantages and disadvantages of a red dot, how to negotiate obstacles like water/fog/mud, and build confidence in the use of your optic. If you are a Firearms Instructor looking to build an optics program for your department or new to a red dot, this course will give you the tools and resources to confidently carry.

Required Materials:

- 1200 rounds of pistol ammo, pistol w/ red dot, handheld or weapon-mounted light
- Duty gear with 3 magazines, eye and ear protection
- Sunscreen and other hot weather gear

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
