Course Outline:

This 40-hour course is requisite to CJSTC certification as a Driving Instructor. Participants will be able to develop and present an effective driving program for their agency. Content and participant success are based on the basic police academy curriculum standards and include cornering, steering, controlled backing, and stopping.

Course Objectives:

- Demonstrate all proficiencies of the BRC Vehicle Operations curriculum
- Identify all components of the BRC Vehicle Operations curriculum and how they must be documented
- Design and teach a section of the BRC Vehicle Operations curriculum

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
